*“Personal copyright laws grant individuals exclusive rights over their creative, original works once fixed in a tangible form, such as writing, music, or art. The creator automatically owns these rights, which include reproducing, distributing, performing, and displaying the work, as well as creating derivative works. To gain the full legal support of the U.S. government, creators should register their work with the U.S. Copyright Office, although this is not necessary to establish the copyright itself.”*

*How to Transfer Copyright*

1. **Create a Written Agreement:**

*The transfer must be documented in writing, such as a contract or a formal assignment agreement.*

2. **Sign the Agreement:**

*The copyright owner (or their authorized agent) must sign the document.*

3. **Be Specific:**

*The agreement should clearly state which exclusive rights are being transferred and for what purpose.*

4. **Record the Transfer (Optional but Recommended):**

*While not required for the transfer to be valid, you can submit the transfer document to the U.S. Copyright Office to record it and create a public record.*
